

# Submission guidelines

When submitting a manuscript to AMAPN, certain guidelines and requirements must be followed:

1. The manuscript should be written in English. To ensure compliance with technical requirements, please use our template file, which can be found at: [AMAPN\\_template.tex](#) ([AMAPN\\_template.pdf](#)). Always make sure to use the latest version of the template file.
2. We expect the submission to be in PDF format, generated from our LaTeX template file. Please send the file to [amapn@nye.hu](mailto:amapn@nye.hu) **with the indication of the area listed on the [AMAPN website](#) to which the manuscript belongs**. All correspondence should be directed to this email address.
3. AMAPN publishes papers that do not exceed 16 pages. Please note that exception to this restriction may be granted in special cases, with the consent of the editor-in-chief.
4. Depending on the reviewer's report, revisions to the manuscript may be requested. The revised version will then be sent back to the reviewer. Once your manuscript is professionally accepted for publication, we will request the LaTeX source file using the AMAPN template file. We will then let you know if the manuscript is technically acceptable or if it requires changes.

## Copyright Statement

Submission of a manuscript implies that the work described has not been published before; that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere; that its publication has been approved by all coauthors, if any, as well as by the responsible authorities at the institute where the work has been carried out; that, if and when the manuscript is accepted for publication, the authors agree to transfer the copyright to the publisher; and that the manuscript will not be published elsewhere in any language without the consent of the copyright holder.

Those versions of the manuscript the author(s) processed and possessed before the galley-proof was sent out to him/her can be uploaded to any repository (e.g. arXiv, ResearchGate, personal homepage). The author(s) can put any part of the manuscript (or the manuscript in whole) in a book - indicating the source (Acta Math. Acad. Paedag. Nyíregyh.).

Although the galley-proof and the version published in AMAPN cannot be uploaded to any repository, they can be sent to individual researchers.

Please ensure that you adhere to these guidelines when submitting your manuscript to AMAPN.
